This will be the largest conference in CRI's history, with 45 panels and more than 250 scholars from the United States and other countries. The panels represent a broad spectrum of the humanities and social sciences, from literary criticism, art history, linguistics, and philosophy to history, sociology, anthropology, economics, and political science. Discussion topics range widely from national identities and racial issues to recent economic and social reforms to health care and investment opportunities in Cuba, to reconciliation between Cubans on and off the Island.

The pre-registration fee (before May 10, 2013) for the general public is \$125, and \$35 for non-FIU students. On-site registration for the general public is \$150.
