Shakespeare, with inimitable eloquence and poetic bravura, weaves a complex existence between the realms of the supernatural and pragmatic reality. In FIU's forthcoming production, director PHILIP M. CHURCH and Musical director JOHN AUGENBLICK bring these two worlds together with the addition of an original score for voices and synthesizer, ensuring a revitalized approach to one of Shakespeare's classic standard dramas. A dynamic cast of young actors will be led by British guest artist TIM CROWTHER, in the title role. Mr. Crowther comes to the stage at FIU with a wide range of professional credits in both British and American theatre.
