Where as, SGA is always striving to create opportunities that will offer student groups continuous growth

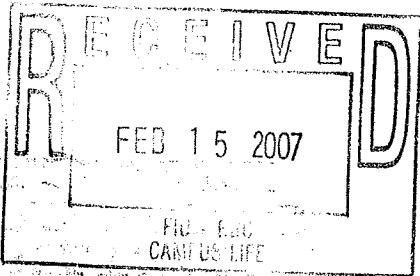
Where as, this event is bringing national recognition to FIU and the Biscayne Bay Campus

Where as, the Science Club is one of the most active clubs on campus in regards to its community service activities and fundraising for its activities on and off campus.



Where as, The current state of the WUC computer lab demands immediate action due to fire hazards, and high maintenance costs coupled with low efficiency rates,

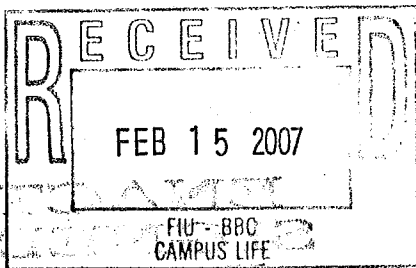
Where as, This will directly benefit the student body by giving them direct access to a high tech computer lab so that they can be more efficient with their school work,

Where as, It will reflect upon the SGC commitment to helping improve the work and study habits of our constituents.


Where as, The Wolfe University Center is contributing a significant amount of capital to this endeavor which shows their commitment of excellence for the students,

Where as, SPC has consistently put on quality events over the past years.


Where as, an anticipated crowd of over 2,000 people will make this the largest event on Campus this year.
