# Background

FIU's Institutional Repository is a full-text, online, open access repository and publishing platform for the scholarship, creative output and history of FIU. The goals of the repository are to:

- Serve as a persistent and centralized access point for FIU scholarship and creative works
- Promote faculty and student research to a global community
- Preserve the history, growth and development of FIU
- Provide a platform for faculty to post Open Access copies of publications to meet OA requirements of funding agencies.

The Institutional Repository is managed and administered by Jill Krefft, Institutional Repository Coordinator; Jamie Rogers, Assistant Department Head Digital Collections Center; with additional support from the staff of the FIU Digital Collections Center, Special Collections and University Archives, and University Graduate School. The repository is hosted by Berkley Electronic Press (BePress), which boasts a strong network of over 500 institutions across the globe. Our repository hosts over 16,000 papers, presentations, reports, images, and videos from more than 60 FIU departments and centers.

## FY 2017-2018 Highlights

- Digital Commons total downloads for 2017-2018 was **499,056**.
- Digital Commons **collections grew by 4,060 new items, more than any past year**.
- DOIs were integrated into uniquely published materials in Digital Commons. Collections with DOIs include all Electronic Theses and Dissertations as well as the journal *Class, Race and Corporate Power* for a total of **3,298 unique DOIs**.
- To improve our user experience, standardized copyright statements were added to all metadata records across all collections using RightsStatement.org and Creative Commons.
- This year there was a strong focus on supporting access to **University Archives materials in Digital Commons. Collections include the BBC SGA Image Archive, FIU in View, and continued development of the Department of Theatre Archive.** (see Collection highlights on page 5 for more details on this project)
- This year we supported the ICOT18 Conference hosted at FIU by providing tools for peer review of over 500 submissions. We also managed the schedule and supported promotion for the five-day event.
- Expanded our **support for graduate student research** beyond the Electronic Theses and Dissertation Collection by providing access to non-thesis and dissertation graduate research.
- Participated in the BePress Selected Works Pilot Program to test harvesting of non IR materials into SelectedWorks profiles.
- Plum Analytics was integrated into the Digital Commons platform for expanded metrics for all researchers.
- With support from **Tech Fee funding**, Digital Collections Center staff in partnership with the Division of IT and Special Collections and University Archives, continued work on the

***retrospective thesis digitization project*** to digitize and make available through Digital Commons the collection of bound theses and dissertations held by the FIU Libraries. To date there are 1,339 retrospective thesis and dissertations in Digital Commons, with almost 60% openly available full text.

## Looking Ahead

For FY 2018-2019, we look forward to

- Work to expose Digital Commons metadata through expanded harvesting activities;
- Continued ingest of retrospective theses and dissertations;
- Continued support of FIU Preeminent Programs and Organizational Research Units;
- Expanding collaborations and partnerships at the university and community levels.

## University Archives, Green Library Florida International University announces the digital collection of the FIU Department of Theatre

Upon meeting Marianna Murray, Office Coordinator, Department of Theatre, one realizes the vast contribution she has made to FIU's Department of Theatre. The Department of Theatre has been a degree granting program since 1972, and Marianna has been safeguarding and archiving the department's history for 18 of those years. Marianna had been looking for a home for the growing collection when we intersected paths and formed a plan to have University Archives house the collection. Along with Marianna, Ivan Lopez, Instructor, Head of Audience Engagement and FIU Alum, Jill Krefft, Institutional Repository Coordinator, Rhia Rae, Digital Archivist and Katharine Labuda, University Archivist Librarian have been working to archive and create a digital record of the department's long history.

In June 2017, students from the Department of Theatre and Digital Collections Center began to scan and process production programs, postcards, and photographs. Ivan worked to provide content to showcase every aspect of the theatre's history and explore aspects of social media, such as crowdsourcing to get alumni involved in creating metadata. Jill utilized the unique structures in Digital Commons to create collections that are organized by season and production, grouping photographs, playbills, posters, videos, and even student newspaper articles all related to the production. In addition, she created a timeline at the top of the collection allowing users to browse the shows and provides direct links to all materials for that production. Thinking beyond the traditional University institutional repository uses, the team created unique digital access to these scholarly, creative, archival materials that have not been traditionally seen in a Digital Commons repository.

**Now Available online 1116 issues of FIU Student Newspapers, University Archives, Green Library, Florida International University.**

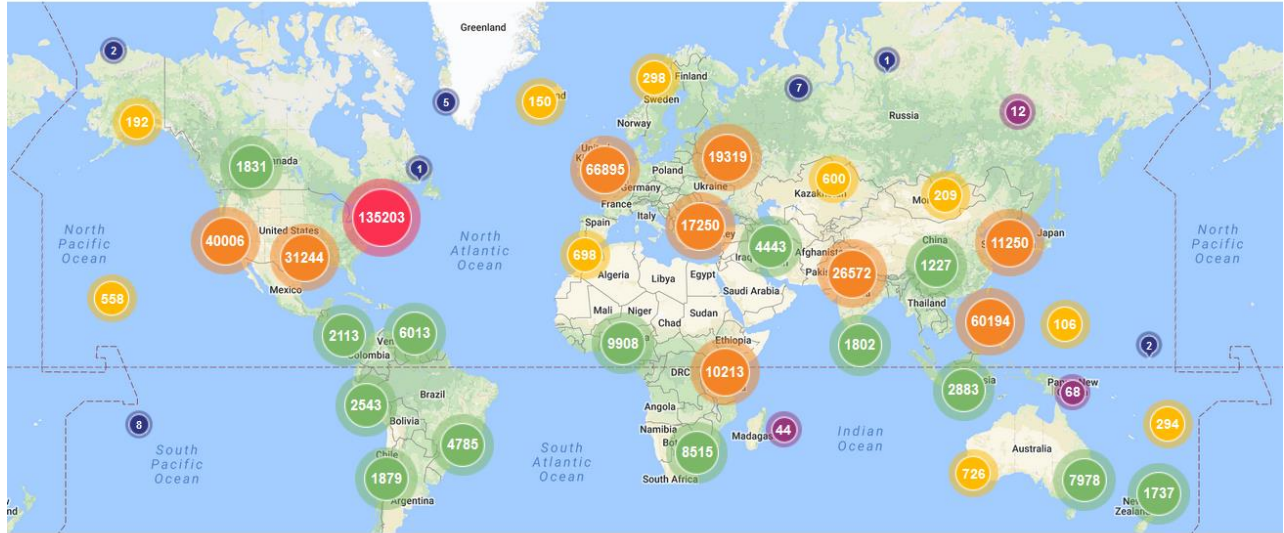
Beginning in 2018, the Special Collections and University Archives (SPCUA) Department began the task of scanning and uploading the earliest editions of the student newspaper for online access. (Current issues of FIU's student newspaper, *Panther Press*, have been available online since 2014) The project is two-fold with the goal of making every issue available online. Under the supervision of Jill Krefft, Institutional Repository Coordinator and Rhia Rae, Digital Archivist, FIU Student Media provides the present-day digital newspaper files for processing and SPCUA library staff scan, process, and upload the historical issues. Special thanks go to FIU freshman, Rosmely Perez for diligently scanning the historical newspaper issues.

The student newspaper provides a wealth of information on the formation of the university, the history of FIU, sports, and student life. The newspaper has gone through several name changes, discontinuations, and at one time two student newspapers were published concurrently. FIU's first student paper was the 4-page newsletter, *Action*, published on November 17, 1972. Now available online are 1116 issues including *Panther Press*, *The Beacon*, *The Action*, *The Good Times*, *The International*, and *The Sentinel* at FIU Digital Commons [http://digitalcommons.fiu.edu/student\\_newspaper/](http://digitalcommons.fiu.edu/student_newspaper/). Keep checking online for new issues.

Original copies of the student newspaper are available in the Special Collections and University Archives Department in the Green Library, MMC, FIU.

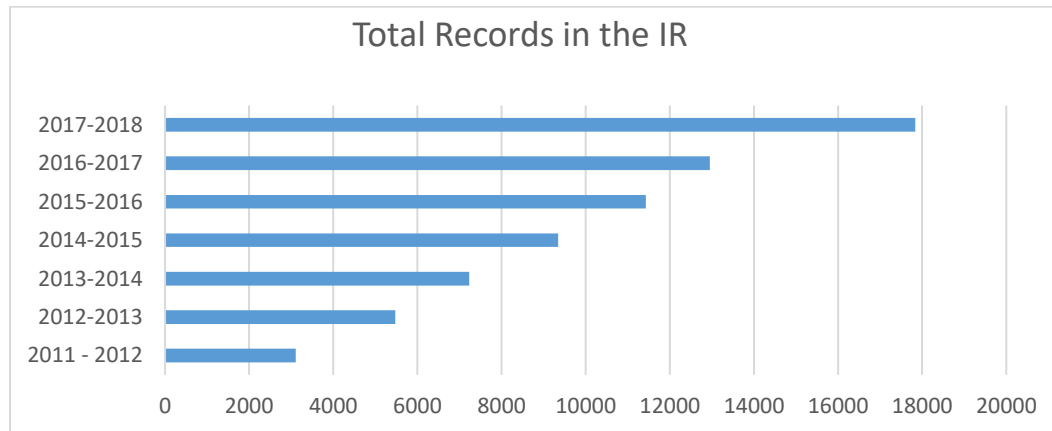

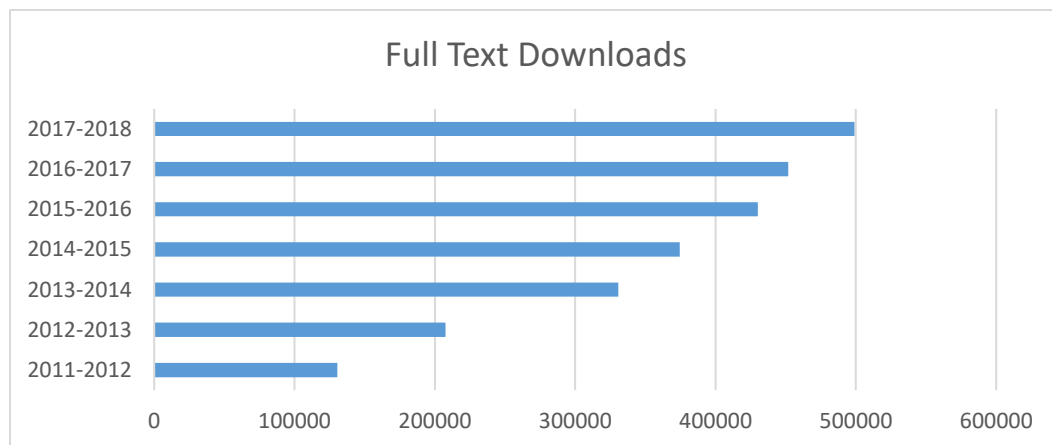


## Growth Over the Years

Digital Commons began tracking its usage in 2011. Since then, collection size has increased annually at a steady pace. Strategic partnerships across campus departments, centers and institutes as well as the development of new strategies for harvesting of content to minimize burden on faculty helped grow the collections this year.



This year we saw our largest number of new records added and our total collection size reflects this growth. **In 2011, our collection included 3,105 items. In 6 years, we have grown our collections to a total of 17,833 items.**



With our continued collection growth our download counts have continually increased as well, demonstrating that we are providing access to meaningful and useful collections.

**In particular, this year Special Collections and University Archives worked to include even more unique collections in Digital Commons, including the Department of**

**Theatre Collection and FIU in View.** This strengthened partnership demonstrates the importance of collaboration in developing new and unique collections.
