Background

FIU's institutional repository Digital Commons is a full-text, online, open access repository and publishing platform for the scholarship, creative output and history of FIU. The goals of the repository are to:

- Serve as a persistent and centralized access point for FIU scholarship and creative works;
- Promote faculty and student research to a global community;
- Preserve the history, growth and development of FIU;
- Provide a platform for faculty to post Open Access copies of publications to meet OA requirements of funding agencies.

The Institutional Repository is managed and administered by the FIU Libraries Digital Collections Center; with additional support from Special Collections and University Archives, and the University Graduate School. More information is available at:

The repository is hosted by Berkley Electronic Press (BePress), which boasts a strong network of nearly 600 institutions across the globe. Our repository hosts over 20,000 papers, presentations, reports, images, and videos from more than 60 FIU departments and centers.

FY 2019-2020 Highlights

- Digital Commons total downloads for 2019-2020 was **585,982**.
- Digital Commons **collections grew by 936 new items**.
- This year, Digital Commons got a whole new look! A complete redesign of the site supports better navigation and branding closely aligned with our digital repositories and collections.
- This year there was a strong focus on expanding existing collections as well as providing access to undergraduate research. This year the institutional repository added 936 items, with over 200 abstracts from the **FIU Undergraduate Research Conference**. In addition, FIU partnered with **Life Sciences South Florida (LSSF) to host proceedings from past undergraduate symposiums** and provide support for upcoming undergraduate research events for students from South Florida Universities.

- Digital Commons expanded its video collections, supporting access to videos including the Annual MLK Breakfast, 2020 Virtual Commencements, Center for Humanities in an Urban Environment and more.
- We continue to publish and archive *electronic theses and dissertations (ETDs)*, which include the works of new FIU graduates as well as retrospective digitization of theses and dissertations dating back to the opening of the university. **210 new ETDs and 211 retrospective ETDs** were published and archived in 2019-2020.
- Created a [landing page](#) to serve as a unified access point for Digital Commons and the Research Data Portal to demonstrate the range of institutional support for publishing, sharing and archiving at FIU.

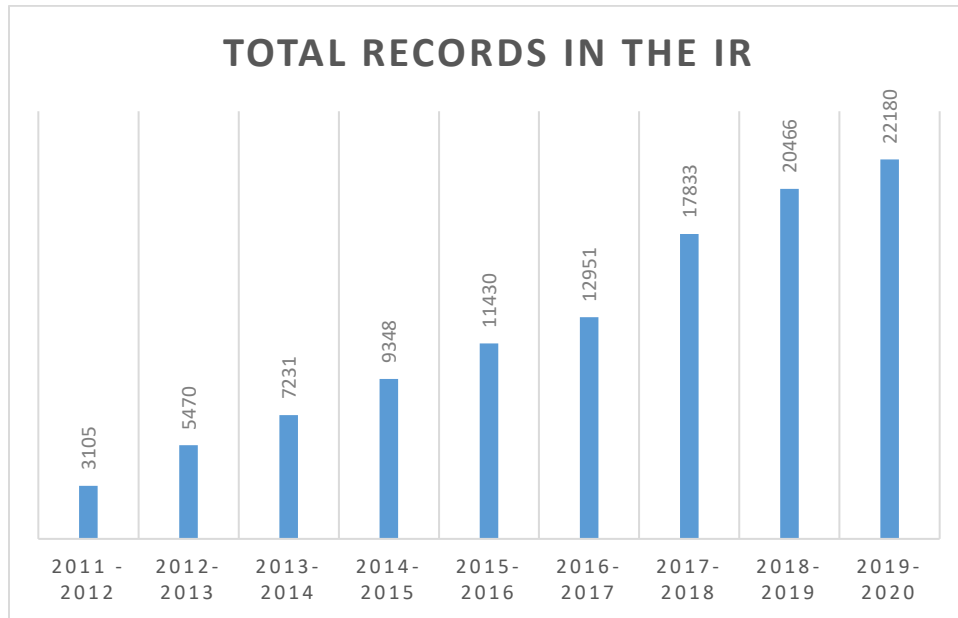

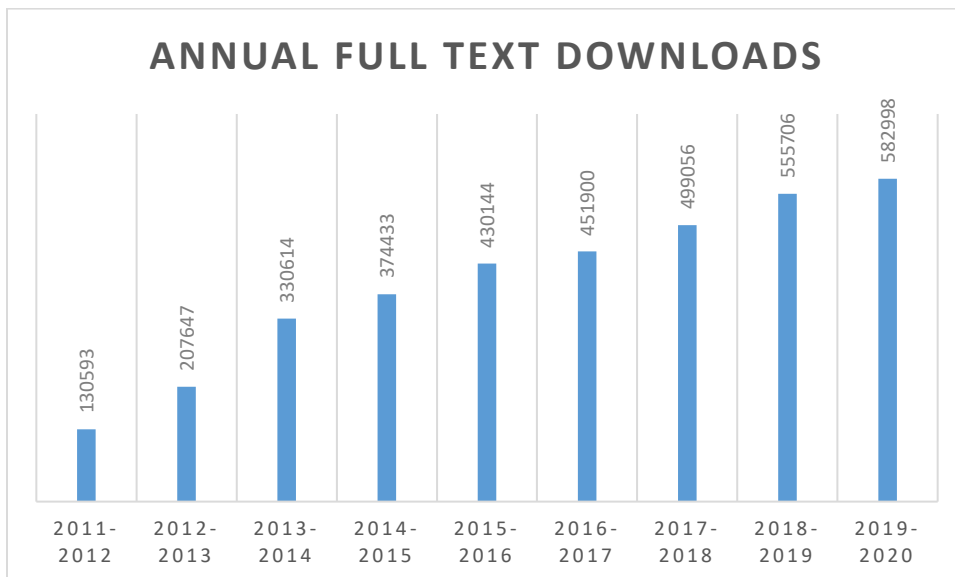

Growth Over the Years

Digital Commons began tracking its usage in 2011. Since then, collection size has increased annually at a steady pace. Strategic partnerships across campus departments, centers and institutes as well as the development of new strategies for harvesting of content to minimize burden on faculty helped grow the collections this year.



In 2011, our collection included 3,105 records. In 8 years, collections have grown to a total of 22,180 records.



With our continued collection growth our download counts have continually increased as well, demonstrating that we are providing access to meaningful and useful collections.
