Sandra Schultz MS '75
Outstanding Alumna

An award-winning educator with more than 30 years of higher ed experience, Sandra Schultz is a professor emerita at Miami-Dade College, an institution she first joined in 1977 as a volleyball and softball coach.

During her career at Miami-Dade (MDC), the Biology Department faculty member was instrumental in the development of the Fitness and Wellness for Life course. One of the college's most enduring courses, it provides students instruction on improving health and nutrition and reducing the risk of cardiovascular disease. Before her retirement in 2011, she began teaching the course online to expand its reach to MDC students all around the world. An accomplished scholar, she also has authored several fitness textbooks.

Still a part of the MDC family, the native Miamian and FSU doctoral alumna was chair of the MDC North Campus' Wellness Day Committee, co-chair of its Learning Outcomes Coordinating Council, and a member of the college's Strategic Plan Committee and Learning Outcomes Assessment Team.

In 2009, Schultz was chosen by the Carnegie Foundation for the Advancement of Teaching and the Council for Advancement and Support of Education as the U.S. Professor of the Year for the state of Florida. She also has received four Endowed Teaching Chairs, including her most recent, the Anastasios and Maria Kyriakides Chair.

The Honorable Ileana Ros-Lehtinen '75, MS '87 *Outstanding Alumna*

Havana-born Ileana Ros-Lehtinen is the representative of Florida's 18th Congressional District and the chair of the House Committee on Foreign Affairs. First elected to Congress in 1989, she is the first Hispanic woman to serve in the U.S. House of Representatives.

A lifelong champion of education who pursued higher education at Miami-Dade Community College, FIU and UM in the years after her family relocated to Miami, Ros-Lehtinen actually began her career as a teacher. She founded and led a private bilingual elementary school in Hialeah, which inspired her first foray into public service. It was her desire to advocate for a stronger educational system, lower taxes and a brighter economic future for her community that fueled her victorious pursuits of seats at the Florida House of Representatives and the Florida Senate in 1982 and 1986.

In the state legislature, she authored the Florida Prepaid College Plan, now the largest pre-paid college tuition program in the nation, and worked to strengthen the Head Start program. She supported legislation to increase the availability to student financial aid and revise the Federal Application for Student Aid process. She remains committed to her constituents and South Florida community, and works to reduce taxes and cut back unnecessary government spending and increase tax incentives for small businesses and middle-class families. She also advocates for fair mortgage lending practices and for first-time homebuyers.

Among the programs that Ros-Lehtinen also supports are the ones that address marriage equality, domestic violence against women – she led the reauthorization of the Violence Against Women Act – and legislation that increases criminal penalties for perpetrators of Medicare fraud. She also is passionate about improving the United States' military, and strives to safeguard veterans' health care and their access to higher education after service.

For her far-reaching work and many contributions to her community, the congresswoman has been recognized by local, state and national organizations.



Honorary Degree

Maurice A. Ferré *Doctor of Public Service*

Puerto Rican-born public servant Maurice A. Ferré is a former six-term mayor of the City of Miami and the first Hispanic mayor of a major American city, serving from 1973-1985. He currently is the chair of the Miami Dade County Expressway Authority and serves on the Florida Transportation Commission.

As mayor, Ferré provided leadership and vision when Miami took its place as one of the world's most vibrant, eclectic and diverse international cities. Throughout his years in office, he focused on economic development, job creation and a visionary approach to improving South Florida's transportation and public infrastructure, as well as on transforming the area into a center for inter-American trade, banking and commerce.

He remains active in business, commentary on current affairs, teaching and in public service. In 2006, he explored issues concerning Puerto Rico, its identity and political status in his book ¿Hacia Dónde Va Puerto Rico? (Where is Puerto Rico Headed?).

His career has been marked by a style of public service that encourages people of widely different views and philosophies to work together in the name of the common good and progress. Ferré himself embarked on that journey early on, first as a member of the Florida House of Representatives from 1966-1967 and then as a commissioner and later mayor of the City of Miami and, years later, as vice chairman of the Dade County Board of Commissioners.

Lady Blanka Rosenstiel
Cal Kovens Distinguished Community Service Award

Warsaw-born philanthropist Lady Blanka Rosenstiel has been an avid promoter of the arts since she settled in Miami with her late husband, Lewis Rosenstiel, the former chairman of Schenley Industries, in the mid-1960s. It was her dedication to helping young artists and her desire to promote Poland's contributions to America that prompted her to establish two nonprofit organizations in the 70s: The American Institute of Polish Culture and The Chopin Foundation.

For the last 40 years, the institute has created hundreds of education programs. These include awarding annual scholarships to students in various areas of study at colleges across the United States, sponsoring lectures and conferences at American universities and presenting historical exhibits at national museums and other educational facilities.

The Chopin Foundation, meanwhile, holds a Miami-based piano competition every five years that yields four finalists selected to represent the United States in The International Chopin Piano Competition, easily the most prestigious musical event in Poland and one of the most anticipated in the world.

An active member of her community and a champion of education, Rosenstiel has received many honors, including the Lady of the Sovereign Order of St. John of Jerusalem, Knights of Malta; FIU's The Society of Founders Award, the Gloria Artis Medal; and the Polish Commander Cross of the Order of Merit.

Wayne E. Chaplin
Cal Kovens Distinguished Community Service Award

As president and chief operating officer of Southern Wine & Spirits of America, Wayne Chaplin is an integral part of the nationally recognized Miami company with more than 12,000 employees and a long history of support to FIU.

It was because of the vision of Chaplin and his father, Harvey Chaplin (the recipient of an honorary FIU doctoral degree), that Southern Wine first became a major benefactor of the Chaplin School of Hospitality and Tourism Management, named in honor of their longstanding generosity. With their support, the school created the Southern Wine & Spirits Beverage Management Center, and established the Harvey R. Chaplin Eminent Scholar Chair in beverage management and the Food Network South Beach Wine & Food Festival. The annual event has returned more than \$16 million to the school, much of it for student scholarships.

A belief in education and hard work has been a constant in Chaplin's life. A UM grad with degrees in business and law, he joined his father in the family business in 1984. During his first decade at Southern Wine, Chaplin worked in a number of positions. In 1987, he was appointed VP of operations. Two years later, he was named first VP and COO.

Chaplin reached his current posts in 1994, remaining focused not only on the company's mission but also on giving back. He has continued his family's philanthropy and community service through a number of local and national charities, and is the current chairman and member of the executive committee at Mount Sinai Hospital.

THE COMMENCEMENT:

An Academic Tradition

At every academic institution, commencement exercises are the high point of the calendar for students and their families. Since the purpose of a college or university is to prepare its students to merit the conferral of an academic degree, the commencement ceremony serves as the instrument for exhibiting the success of both the university and its students in fulfilling this primary goal. The rites involved in the celebration of commencement stem from civilization's earliest times. In fact, the very word, commencement, means a beginning. If you are familiar with the trappings of this grand ceremony, you are aware that the traditions carried forth from medieval days are revealed in all of their pomp, color and symbolism. It is a celebration of new beginnings. For participants and observers alike, commencement is meant to be both self-serving and an emotional experience.

The Chain of Office

The University President is the ceremony's convener and chief presider at the commencement ceremonies. The great chain, which is the FIU chain of office, is displayed on stage. This ancient symbol is perhaps the most beautiful and artistic of any of the accoutrements of the ceremony. During the Renaissance, holders of very high office sometimes wore a chain as a symbol of their authority. FIU's chain is made of sterling silver and its designs are cast, cut and etched. The center medallion represents the world and is surrounded by sea shells cast from an actual shell. Reflecting the university and the South Florida area are the eight ovals which make up the chain. Each link is connected by a shell motif and exemplifies a specific entity: 1) the University Park tower, 2) the Vrana sculpture over the entrance of Primera Casa, and 3) the Torch of Friendship. The others represent the five original schools in the FIU community: Arts and Sciences, Business, Education, Hospitality Management, and Engineering. Inscribed upon four of the medallions are the names and dates of tenure of FIU presidents — Charles Perry, Harold Crosby, Gregory Wolfe, Modesto A. Maidique. The chain was designed by Dr. Clem Pennington, associate professor of art education, now retired, and executed in 1977 by Leo Shirker, a Miami goldsmith, art teacher and FIU alumnus.

The Mace

The Grand Marshal carries a ceremonial club called a mace. In antiquity, when an official of high rank went out in public, a mace-bearer was assigned to accompany him in order to literally beat away those who got close enough to try to petition the favors of the official. Today, the bearing of the university's mace is ceremonial in nature, signifying the authority and authenticity of those who are to follow.

Music

Music plays an important role in the commencement experience. The commencement procession begins with the playing of Aaron Copland's Fanfare for the Common Man. It is followed by the familiar Pomp and Circumstance March #1, by Sir Edward Elgar. This march, one of a set of five Pomp and Circumstance marches by Elgar, is traditionally played at commencement ceremonies throughout the United States, and many places around the world. It has come to symbolize the commencement experience. After the processional, and after the academic body is assembled, our national anthem, The Star Spangled Banner, is played. The National Anthem is followed by the FIU Alma Mater, a piece of FIU symbolism composed by Clair McElfresh of the FIU Music faculty, former dean of undergraduate studies, and now retired.

Marshals

The leader of the academic procession is the Grand Marshal. At FIU, this prestigious honor goes to the chairperson of the Faculty Senate, which is the democratic collegial governance body of the faculty. You will notice that as the Grand Marshal processes, the mace (a formidable weapon) is held at port arms, the ready position for quick protection. Faculty and student marshals have been elected to lead candidates for graduation from each of the university's schools and colleges.

The Dais Party

The Dais Party is also known as the Platform Party. This group is composed of the university's administrative leaders and very special guests. The Dais Party enters the hall before the faculty and proceeds directly to stage. At the end of the processional, the Grand Marshal declares the proceedings open, and the ceremony moves forward.

Academic Regalia

The tradition of wearing distinctive academic attire at commencement ceremonies originated in Europe in the twelfth century. However, gowns and capes had been worn by clerics and ecclesiastics even before that date. A heavy black or brown gown was apparently worn at all times. Hoods and capes were also a necessity during the long, cold European winters because the buildings in which scholars lived, studied and taught were cold and drafty. When not being used to provide warmth, hoods and baggy sleeves served the same purpose as do today's pockets. Often a crust of bread or some cheese were tucked away in them for sustenance on a long journey. The academic costume at English universities (from which many of our American commencement traditions originate) can be traced as far back as the middle of the fourteenth century, to the time

when scholars were rebuked that a decent habit was to be worn (Statutes of Peterhouse, 1344). This document further prescribed the code of dress for university teachers of that era. In a 1432 statute, students and even doctors of theology were restricted to bunge and sad-colored habits. The robes of master were to be flowing and reach the ankles. In an order dated 1358, tailors were admonished not to stint the robes, which should be argae et talares, because clerks (of whom scholars were one type) should be distinguished from the laity. A few universities still require students and faculty to wear a short gown both on and off the university campus. Oxford, Cambridge and some Scottish universities maintain this custom. The faculties of American universities have worn academic garb for commencement ceremonies since the beginning of the system. For almost 250 years, each university chose its own costume until it was realized that in 1896 an event unique in history would be taking place. This was the simultaneous celebrations of the 250th anniversary of Harvard University and the 500th anniversary of Heidelberg University. Because of this unique circumstance, the Intercollegiate Bureau of Academic Costume was opened in 1895 to record the distinctive colors of institutions, their arrangement, the particulars of gowns, hoods and caps, as well as information pertaining to academic ceremonies. At that time, an American code of academic dress was agreed upon to which we adhere today with few modifications. Since Spring 2011, FIU has selected to use earth-friendly academic regalia for undergraduate and graduate students. The fabric is manufactured from molten plastic pellets recycled from approximately 23 water bottles and feels like traditional fabric. This initiative underlines FIU's commitment to sustainability.

Gowns

Academic gowns of today are most easily identified by the distinctive style of their sleeves. The bachelor's gown is worn closed and its sleeves are long, open and pointed. The master's gown can be worn either open or closed, and has long distinctive sleeves which are closed, with a slit near the elbow to free the hand and forearm. These pointed sleeves hang down from the elbow to below the hand. The doctor's gown can be worn either opened or closed, and has five inches of velvet trim down both front edges, and three velvet chevrons on each sleeve. The velvet trim may be either black or the color of the discipline in which the degree is granted. The sleeves are closed and bloused.

Hoods

Probably the greatest degree of symbolism is expressed with the academic hood. Those who hold bachelor's degrees and participate in commencement sometimes wear a hood. Candidates for the bachelor's degree do not. The bachelor's hood is black and is three-feet long, with a two-inch velvet border in the color of discipline in which the degree is awarded. The master's hood is also of black material, and is three-and-one-half feet long with a three-inch velvet border in the color of the discipline. It is lined with the colors of the institution conferring

the degree. The doctor's hood is four-feet long, has a five-inch velvet border in the the color of the discipline, and is lined with the colors of the institution granting the degree.

Caps

Traditionally, the Oxford style square cap is considered proper headdress. In recent times, however, it has become stylish to wear a soft cap of either square or octagonal shape. All graduates wear a tassel over the left side of the cap. Bachelor's and master's tassels may be black or the color of the academic discipline, while doctor's tassels are always gold.

These are by no means all of the styles or accoutrements worn as academic dress. Indeed, in South American, Spanish and Dutch universities, the academic attire can be likened to plumage. It is not uncommon to see brightly colored gowns adorned with ermine and other furs, flowing capes, and caps trimmed with beads or tassels. Some universities in South America even add Indian feathers to the headdress, in honor of the Inca Indians. At Florida International University, whose colors are blue and gold, the traditional colors of the disciplines are:
