ORADOR DE LA GRADUACION

CHARLES E. PERRY

Esta graduación, la séptima en la historia de la Universidad, será la última tarea oficial del Presidente Perry antes de dejar la Florida International University para seguir una nueva carrera en la industria de las comunicaciones. Como Presidente Fundador de la Universidad desempeñó el papel principal en la creación de una institución educacional avanzada que hoy día está en cuarto lugar en el sistema universitario de la Florida con más de 10,000 estudiantes matriculados, más de 1,500 empleados y miembros de la facultad y con estimulantes facilidades multi-millonarias en la planta universitaria.

In julio de 1969, a la edad de 32 años, el Dr. Perry fue nombrado Presidente Fundador de la Florida International University y se convirtió el presidente más joven de una universidad estatal en toda la nación. Su misión era construir una nueva universidad estatal en el mayor centro de población en la Florida.

En el corto plazo de tres años, empezando con tres empleados en la torre de control de un aeropuerto abandonado y un presupuesto de \$350,000, dirigió los esfuerzos monumentales en la creación de la Florida International University, que abrió en

septiembre de 1972 con 5,667 estudiantes -- más que ninguna otra institución en su primer año en la historia de la educación avanzada en América. Para mantenerse al día con la demanda de facilidades de la institución situada en un área urbana e internacionalmente orientada, también dirigió el planeamiento de una segunda planta que estará situada en Interama al lado de la Bahía de Biscayne en North Miami.

El Presidente Perry ha recibido muchos premios y honores, incluyendo el ser nombrado uno de los Diez Hombres Sobresaliente en America por los Jaycees de los Estados Unidos en el 1971. En el 1973 recibió la Medalla de Honor de la Sociedad Acción Pro Darién de Colombia, Suramérica. En el 1975 el Dr. Perry fue nombrado "Educador Sobresaliente de América" por Fuller & Dees en reconocimiento de sus contribuciones a la educación en el nivel superior y sus servicios a la comunidad. Su honor más reciente fue la selección este año como Ex-Alumno Distinguido de la Bowling Green State University, en Ohio.

El Presidente, su señora y dos hijos se mudarán a Nueva York donde Perry se dedicará a negocios privados.

EL RECIPIENTE DEL TITULO HONORARIO

J. WILLARD MARRIOTT, JR.

Cuando J. Willard Marriott, Jr. nació los restaurantes Hot Shoppes de su padre habían estado abiertos por cinco años y más tarde el joven empezó a trabajar en ellos mientras cursaba estudios de segunda enseñanza. Después de recibir un título en banca y financiamiento de la Universidad de Utah y servir en un portaaviones como oficial de abastecimientos, Marriott pasó a dirigir el primer hotel para motoristas de la compañía. Avanzó en la jerarquía de la corporación y se hizo presidente en el 1964. En el 1972 reemplazó a su padre como ejecutivo supremo. Después de haber aumentado las ventas casi diez veces

en el negocio de restaurante/albergue/provisión de aerolineas como presidente, empezó a incrementar los servicios ofrecidos por la compañía. La corporación Marriott se ha hecho una de las más diversificadas en la industria de viaje/recreación del país. Marriott tiene un título honorario en Letras Humanitarias de la Southeastern University y un premio en Administración de Negocios de Drexel. Continúa activo en organizaciones cívicas y de negocios y en la Iglesia Mormona. Fue nombrado Obispo de la sección de Cheby Chase de la Iglesia de Jesucristo Santo del Ultimo Día este año.

COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER

CHARLES E. PERRY

This Commencement, the seventh in the University's history, will be President Perry's last formal assignment prior to his leaving Florida International University for a new career in the communications industry. As the University's Founding President he played the leading role in creating an institution of higher education that today is the fourth largest state university in Florida with an enrollment of more than 10,000 students, a faculty and staff reaching the 1,500 level and an exciting multi-million dollar campus.

In July, 1969, at the age of 32, Dr. Perry was named the Founding President of Florida International University and became the youngest state university president in the nation. His assignment was to build a new state university in Florida's largest population center.

In the short space of three years, starting with a staff of three headquartered in the control tower of an abandoned airport and a budget of \$350,000, he headed the massive effort to create Florida International University which opened in

September of 1972 with 5,667 students -- more than any first year enrollment in the history of American higher education. To keep pace with demand for the facilities of an urban-centered and internationally oriented university, he also led the planning for a second campus to be located at the Interama Site on Biscayne Bay in North Miami.

President Perry has received many awards and honors, including being named one of the Ten Outstanding Young Men in America by the U.S. Jaycees for the year 1971. In 1973 he received the Medal of Honor from Accion Pro Darien Society of Columbia, South America. In 1975 Dr. Perry was named "Outstanding Educator of America" by Fuller and Dees in recognition of contributions to the advancement of higher education and service to the community. His latest honor in 1975 was selection as the Distinguished Alumnus of Bowling Green State University, Ohio.

President and Mrs. Perry and their two children will move to New York where Perry will enter private business.

HONORARY DEGREE RECIPIENT

J. WILLARD MARRIOTT, JR.

His father's Hot Shoppes restaurants had been in business five years when J. Willard Marriott, Jr. was born and young Marriott started working in them when he was in high school. After a degree in banking and finance from the University of Utah and a stint as a ship's service supply officer on an aircraft carrier, Marriott took over directing the company's first motor hotel. He worked his way up the corporate ranks and became president in 1964. In 1972 he succeeded his father as chief executive officer. Having increased sales almost ten times in the restaurant/lodging/airline catering businesses as president,

he began expanding the company's services. The Marriott Corporation has become the most diversified firm in the Country's travel/leisure services industry. Marriott has an honorary degree in Humane Letters from Southeastern University and a Business Administration Award from Drexel. He is active in business and civic organizations and in the Mormon Church. He was named Bishop of the Chevy Chase Ward of the Church of Jesus Christ of the Latter-Day Saints in 1975.

EXPLANATION OF ACADEMIC ATTIRE

Rules for scholarly attire at Oxford and Cambridge Universities influenced the adoption, in 1895, of the U. S. Intercollegiate Code. The Code establishes the design, fabric, color, and trim of academic ceremonial robes.

The Oxford-style square hat, the "mortarboard," is seen more often than the soft, round pileus. The design of the gown indicates the degree earned; color of hood trim denotes area of study; and, hood lining shows school colors. The Bachelor's gown, worn closed, has long, pointed sleeves. The Master's degrees in this ceremony.

EXPLICACION DE LA INDUMENTARIA ACADEMICA

El estilo de la toga académica empleada hoy en las ceremonias formales de las universidades norteamericanas tiene una historia que remota a las comunidades de eruditos en la Europa medieval. A la medida que se desarrollaban estas comunidades en instituciones docentes y de investigación, la toga académica se limitaba estrictamente para indicar el campo, la categoría del individuo. Esto se observa especialmente en las universidades inglesas de Oxford y Cambridge, de las cuales hemos heredado gran parte de nuestra tradición.

En 1895 se promulgó en los Estados Unidos el Código Interuniversitario que fija el dibujo, la tela, el color y el adorno de la toga académica. El sombrero cuadrado o esparavel, el adaptación de la tradición de Oxford, y se ve más frecuentemente que el sombrero flexible y circular que se llama pileo.

Según dicho Código, el dibujo de la toga indica el título del individuo, el color del adorno de la muceta indica el campo de estudio; y el forro de la muceta ostenta los colores de la escuela.

La toga del Bachiller tiene mangas largas y puntiagudas, y se viste cerrada. Es cuadrilonga la manga del Licenciado, con una extensión cuadrada por detrás, y por delante se observa una forma de arco. La toga del Doctor tiene mangas acampanadas y se adorna con entrepaños de terciopelo. En esta ceremonia aquellos que reciben títulos de Maestría visten mucetas que penden sobre la espalda. Los colores tradicionales de las borlas y adornos de Florida International University son:
