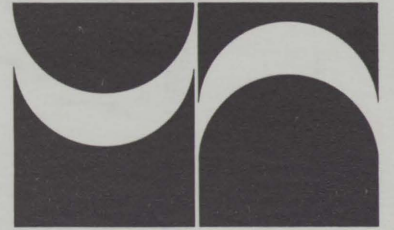
William's characters are so vividly drawn, the language so beautifully composed and the play so masterfully constructed, that "*Streetcar*" has all the dramatic impact today that it had when

first performed 30 years ago. It is a theatre event not to be missed, either as a first time experience, or as a renewed contact with the best of modern theatre.

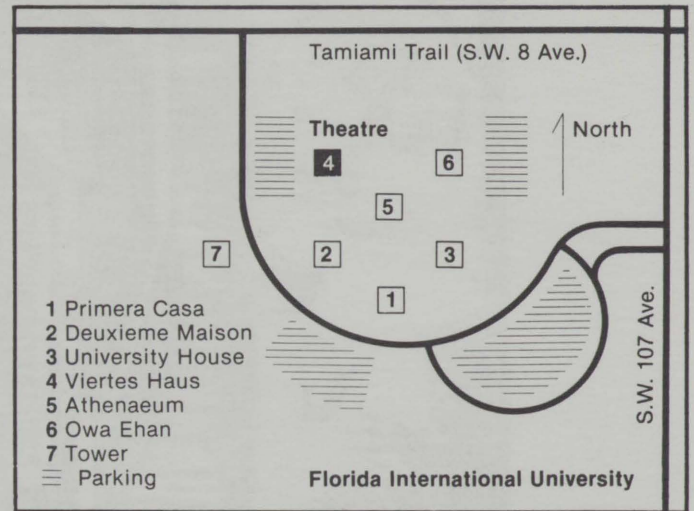
