## Bridge/Breezeway Use of Space

General Report

## Survey Authors:

#### Survey Purpose:

The purpose of this survey is to gain insights into how students utilize the Bridge/Breezeway, a designated space within the Green Library on the second floor between the elevator lobby and GRID. We aim to understand the duration of student visits, the activities they engage in while in the space, and their technological preferences and needs. This information will guide us in enhancing the Bridge/Breezeway to better cater to our students' academic and collaborative needs.

## Methodology:

The survey was designed to be concise and efficient, consisting of three key questions aimed at understanding student usage of the Bridge/Breezeway. The survey was conducted over a period of five days, from March 4 to March 8, 2024.

To ensure maximum visibility and participation, the survey was promoted through digital signage strategically placed within the Bridge/Breezeway. This allowed us to effectively reach out to the students who frequently use the space.

In addition to the digital promotion, the authors of the survey took a more direct approach to gather feedback. We walked through the Bridge/Breezeway multiple times during the survey period, engaging with students in the space. This provided an opportunity for real-time interaction and feedback collection, ensuring a comprehensive understanding of student needs and preferences in the Bridge/Breezeway.

### **Executive Summary**

- The survey solicited 243 responses during the distribution period (N=243)
- **79% of respondents** use the Bridge/Breezeway for either individual (32%; N=138) or group (39%; N=168) study
- **71% of respondents** who use the Bridge/Breezeway for study purposes make **long term** use of the space (N=157)
- 74% of respondents who use the Bridge/Breezeway for hanging out also make long term use of the space (N=90)
- The suggestions concentrate on **Booths**, **Tables**, and **Chairs** as the respondents' primary concern in the study area.
- Frequent mention of Whiteboards suggests their importance as a tool for individual or group study.




## Percent breakdown of respondents' use of the space

- 63.7% of respondents stated that they **study** in the Bridge/Breezeway and **do not hang out there** (N=155)


