He has been a professor and researcher at the Universidad de La Habana and the Instituto Superior de Relaciones Internacionales (ISRI), in Havana, Cuba. Professor Hernández has also been the director of U.S. studies at the Centro de Estudios sobre América (CEA) and a Senior Research Fellow at the Instituto Cubano de Investigación Cultural Juan Marinello (1996-2008). He has taught as a visiting professor at Harvard, Columbia, University of Texas, Centro de Investigación y Docencia Económicas (CIDE), Instituto Tecnológico Autónomo de México (ITAM), and the Universidad de Puerto Rico (UPR). His publications include *The History of Havana; Looking at Cuba: Essays on Culture and Civil Society; Sin urna de cristal: Pensamiento y cultura en Cuba; and Otra guerra: Ensayos cubanos sobre estrategia y seguridad internacional*.
