101.01 All Student Government Statutes These SGC-BBC Statutes can be amended by no less than 3/2 vote of the entire Senate.

101.02 Senate bills to amend Statutes shall require two (2) readings if it involves changing only one title article or chapter. Bills that are amending amend more than two titles articles or chapters will require three (3) readings from the Senate.
