
Clarification as “President of the Senate”

Section 1: In section 202.05 (Assumptions of Duties). It was clarified and changed from “Senate President” to “President of the Senate” as expressed in other legislative documents e.g. The SGA Constitution

Section 2: 202.05 Assumptions of Duties:

(i) Duties, rights and responsibilities shall vest upon confirmation by Senate and upon taking the oath of office. The ~~Senate President~~ President of the Senate or Speaker of the Senate shall be responsible for administering the oath.

Section 3: This proposed bill shall be implemented as soon as a super majority of the Senate passes it.
