Chapter 101 Amendments to the Statutes

101.01 <u>All Student Government Statutes</u> <u>The SGC-BBC Statutes</u> can be amended <u>by no</u> <u>less than ²/₃ vote of the entire Senate.</u>

101.02 Senate bills to amend Statutes shall require two (2) readings if it involves changing only one title article or chapter. Bills that are amending amend more than two titles articles or chapters will require three (3) readings from the Senate.

Section 3: This proposed bill shall be implemented immediately after it is passed by a Super Majority of the Senate.
