Born in the 1950s in South Africa, Johann Zietsman grew up under the apartheid regime and first got involved in the arts as a brass player in his high school band. This led to his lifelong passion for the transformative value and role of the arts in a

Ithaca, New York, where he completed a master's degree in music.

Returning to South Africa in 1982, Zietsman started a 20-year career in various executive arts management positions, including a music school, two orchestras, an opera and music theatre company, a community arts center, a large multi-theatre

performing arts company, and a commercial communications

During this time, he was actively involved in the political transformation of his homeland through pioneering work in the arts, resulting in recognition from Mr. Nelson Mandela's government. As a volunteer, he launched and directed two community youth initiatives, which currently serve about 4000

After serving in the military, he earned a bachelor's degree in architecture. Then Zietsman and his wife, Tharrie, moved to

at-risk children in townships.

In 2002, Zietsman and his family moved to the United States when he was recruited by the International Society for the Performing Arts (ISPA), based in New York City. In June 2007 they moved to Mesa, Arizona, where Zietsman served as Executive Director of the Mesa Arts Center, and Director of Arts and Culture for the city of Mesa.

In December 2009, Zietsman accepted the position of President

and CEO of EPCOR CENTRE for the Performing Arts, now known as **Arts Commons**, in Calgary, AB, Canada. Under his leadership, Arts Commons transformed into a resilient and dynamic value-driven organization – a place of equity, diversity
