He has served as consultant to numerous international organizations such as the United Nations and the Interamerican Development Bank. In 1979 he was recruited by Florida International University (FIU) to chair its Department of Economics and he is currently Professor and Director of the Economic Research Center at FIU. Dr. Salazar-Carrillo has authored or coauthored 90 books and hundreds of articles in professional journals. He is also a frequent collaborator of the newspaper *El Nuevo Herald* and a frequent guest in numerous programs on current political affairs on radio and television.
