Cristobal Diaz-Ayala was born in Havana, Cuba. He studied at the University of Havana, where he attended the School of Journalism, obtained a degree in Social Sciences, and also attended the School of Law where he earned his law degree. Diaz-Ayala immigrated to Puerto Rico in 1960, and was admitted by the Puerto Rican Law Association in 1966. He has published hundreds of articles and more than a dozen books related to Cuban and Latin American Music.


