The concert will be devoted to romantic piano compositions and lyric music from Cuba from the 19th and early 20th centuries, including well-known titles by Ernesto Lecuona, Gonzalo Roig, and Jorge Anckermann.

**José Ruiz Elcoro** is a Cuban pianist and musicologist, specializing in Iberoamerican music. He is currently a pianist for the Miami City Ballet. He earned his B.A. in Philology at the University of Havana and graduated from the Ignacio Cervantes Conservatory in Havana. As a piano performer and lecturer, he has appeared in numerous stages and universities in Asia, Africa, Europe, and the Americas.

Born in Holguín, Cuba, soprano **Eglise Gutiérrez** has sung in some of the most prestigious venues of the world. She made her debut at the Royal Opera House, Covent Garden, during the 2009–2010 season as Linda di Chamonix. She made her Berlin Deutsche Oper Debut as Lucia in *Lucia di Lammermoor*. Ms. Gutiérrez has also appeared in concert in Prague, Cannes, Helsinki, and Miami, and in a U.S. tour with Andrea Bocelli.
