CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 5:10 p.m. by President Safiya Burton.

Approval of minutes

Ms. Burton requested that the Council read through the minutes from the previous meeting. Ms. Lakisha Holmes made a motion to accept the minutes. Ms. Dannielle Boyer seconded the motion. The vote passed unanimously.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT

- With regard to the document that was distributed to Council members, Ms. Burton had a meeting with Dr. Gallaghar, and she informed the Council that the matter is under investigation. Student Government Council shall not proceed with any action until a report is published on the matter.
- Members who are not attending the Law Rally are encouraged to attend the Orientation activities that will be taking place.
- A special thanks to Ms. Boyer who made flyers for the Law Rally and really encouraged student to sign up for the trip.
