Imagine an MRI of an economy. It provides the most intimate details of how that economy operates. It provides the sources of production, the interactions among them, and how production in one activity is intertwined with what happens in another sector. The resource used in any activity will generate demand for goods in the rest of the economy. The demand will require the hiring of labor, the use of capital, the activities of entrepreneurs, and the demand for space to accommodate these new processes. The result is a multiplication of production and income, which determines how balanced its distribution is among the members of society. This process produces a general equilibrium in the economy, from which the corresponding payment to families that own the resources, will define its income distribution or social accounting.

Dr. Jorge Salazar-Carrillo is Professor of Economics and Director of the Economic Research Center at Florida International University. He earned his Ph.D. and M.A. in economics, with a certificate in development analysis and planning, at the University of California, Berkeley. His professional activity has developed within prestigious institutions such as the Brookings Institution and Georgetown University. He has served as consultant to numerous international organizations such as the United Nations and the Interamerican Development Bank. Dr. Salazar-Carrillo has authored or coauthored 90 books and hundreds of articles in professional journals. He is also a frequent collaborator of the newspaper *El Nuevo Herald* and a frequent guest in numerous programs on current political affairs on radio and television.
