# **Designation of House Meeting Time**

An act in relation to a designated day and time for House meetings.

- Be it enacted by the Student Government Association of Florida International University at the University Park Campus
- Section 1: Under Article IV, Section C of the SGC-UP By Laws, there is no designated time or day for House meetings to take place. Unfortunately, this makes it difficult to coordinate a meeting day and time once all House representatives have been elected. In order to remedy this situation, it is proposed that representatives elected to office must designate Mondays from 4:00 pm to 6:00 pm for House meetings.
- Section 2: The SGC-UP By Laws will be amended as follows: Article IV, Section C will now read:
- C. Meetings The House shall assemble no less than once a month to perform aforementioned duties. House meetings shall be designated in accordance with the following specifications:
  - <u>1. For the purpose of regular meetings, the House will meet on Mondays at 4:00 PM in the</u> SGA Conference Room. Representative's schedules must be made around this time. Meetings will last a maximum of two (2) hours.

1. a. The House shall assemble no less than bi-weekly during active legislative sessions of the SGC-UP.

2. b. The House shall assemble no less than once a month during inactive sessions of the SGC-UP.

- 3. House meetings shall occur at the time/date/location-designated by the Speaker of the House who shall take into consideration all representatives schedules and designate a time suitable to the majority of the House.
- 2. For the purpose of scheduling committee meetings, official academic school schedules will be taken into consideration. These must be submitted to the Chief of Staff no later

than two (2) weeks prior to the beginning of the semester to allow for adequate planning time.

4.<u>3.</u> The Speaker of the House may at his/her discretion call additional meetings as necessary.

Section 3: These changes to the By Laws will become effective in the Spring 2006 semester, pending the ratification by the student body at the next University Election at University Park.
