CALL TO ORDER

The Student Government Association (BBC) held a meeting on January 20, 2012, in WUC 155. The meeting was called to order at **3:37pm**, approximately, by President Halpin who presided over the meeting in its entirety.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Speaker Haspel motioned to approve the minutes for November 30th, Senator Usma seconded the motion. With a unanimous vote, the motion passed.

PRESIDNET'S REPORT

President Halpin began her report by stating that she meet with Howard Litman, before the bowl game, to come up with a strategy to get more students to attend bowl games at possibly a cheaper price.soem ideas that were given was maybe having a banquet where the ticket price would be \$ 100. The only downside would be that students might not want to pay \$100 for a ticket. However the invitation could be extended to alumni.
