CALL TO ORDER

The Student Government Association (BBC) held a General meeting on January 29, 2014, WUC 221. The meeting was called to order at 3:33PM, approximately, by President Zhou-Wu who presided over the meeting in its entirety.

PRESIDENT'S WELCOME

- President Zhou-Wu recognized the newly elected SGA-BBC members, as well as the MAST Academy's Student Government members, who were guests at today's meeting.
- Chief Justice Periche asked everyone in attendance to refrain from using their cell phones during the meeting.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT

- President Zhou-Wu began her report by saying that SGA-BBC was successful in getting a One Card reload station moved closer to the bus stop; a re-load station will be added near the entrance of AC1.
- President Zhou-Wu stated that the broken electronic sign near the entrance of campus will be replaced soon, with an upgraded model that should last at least 10 years
- President Zhou-Wu said that the renovation of WUC should be completed by March 31. She said that she needs one or two more members to volunteer to be a part of the WUC advisory committee, since the prior member Kenley Jean-Louis, left. The WUC advisory committee assists in making decisions for the renovations being made to WUC.
- Finally, President Zhou-Wu stated that SGA-BBC has been working closely with SGA-MMC on working to lower tuition for veterans. More info to follow soon.

VICE-PRESIDENT REPORT

- Vice-President Azimov stated that there should be a Starbucks installed in the Hubert Library by fall of 2014. A Subway sandwich shop, which will take over the space of Bistro subs and the Bay Café, is expected to be installed by fall of 2014.
- Vice-President Azimov reminded members to keep tabling for the Second Road Access campaign. He also thanked members for all of their involvement
- Vice-President Azimov asked council members to take flyers for the upcoming Town Hall Meeting and Lecture and to pass them out in classes.

COMPTROLLER REPORT

• Comptroller Dehaarte said that there is an upcoming budget hearing on Feb. 6 at the south campus.

SPEAKER OF THE SENATE REPORT

- Speaker Honore stated that there are two new at-large senators, one arts and sciences senator, one journalism senator, and two hospitality senators. She stated, however, that there are still open positions that need to be filled.
- Speaker Honore also said that the finance code was approved at the last meeting.

CHIEF OF STAFF

- Chief of Staff Nieves said that all cabinet members should be tabling for two hours for the second road campaign. She emphasized the need for involvement with this campaign.
- Chief of Staff Nieves said that there are still some cabinet positions that need to be filled. Current members should recruit potential members.

CHIEF JUSTICE REPORT

- Chief Justice Periche thanked everyone for coming to the meeting on time.
- Chief Justice Periche announced that the first Justice meeting will be on Feb. 2 at 3:30 p.m.
- Finally, Chief Justice Periche stated that she would like to have a potential council wide presentation on how to create an agenda/chair a meeting on Feb. 3 at 1p.m.

ADVISOR REPORT

- Mr. Zapata encouraged members to sign up for the Leadership Summit this Saturday.
- Mr. Zapata stated that council members should show up and support SGA at the W. KAmau Bell lecture event on Feb. 5 at 6:30 p.m.
- Mr. Zapata said that members are expected to be present and involved in the potential upcoming North Miami city council meeting concerning the second road access.
- Finally, Mr. Zapata said that members should encourage fellow students to attend the Town Hall meeting on Feb.10, because President Rosenberg is typically very engaged and concerned with the students.

NEW BUSINESS

- 1. New Appointment: Special Events Coordinator
 - Guolin Zhou is a senior studying hospitality. She is currently the marketing coordinator for China's Hospitality Association and has held an internship with the Hilton Hotels Corporation.
