SPEAKER REPORT

• Speaker Honore stated that SGA-BBC members should attend the WUC grand opening on March 31. Members should wear their blue council shirts.

SPEAKER PRO REPORT

• Senator Mejia stated he will be representing SGA-BBC at the Pines Center from April 14-17 during Stress Relief Week. If members are interested to volunteer promoting SGA-BBC, they should let Senator Mejia know as soon as possible.

VICE-PRESIDENT REPORT

- Vice-President Azimov told members that if they are interested in attending Rally and Tally this Wednesday, they need to let him know as soon as possible. He emphasized that SGA-BBC representation is very important.
