

Re: NACA Travel costs to be assumed by travellers.

Date: Wednesday, September 18, 1996

This is to inform you that the Student Government Council voted on September 6, 1996, to allocate no more than one thousand dollars out of the SGC travel fund to allow two SGC members to travel to the NACA Conference in Charlotte, North Carolina from September 26 through September 29, 1996. It was further voted by the Council that the students travelling to this Conference would each be funded \$500 towards the costs associated with the conference, and that these students would assume responsability to pay out of their own pocket any costs above \$500.
