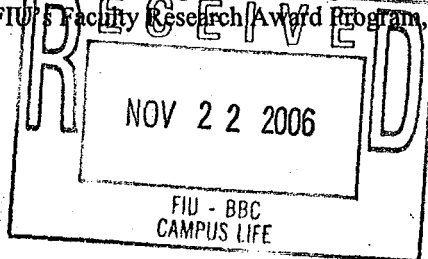
Whereas, FIU should be providing ample opportunities for undergraduates to participate in the cutting-edge research going on at this institution everyday,

Whereas, participation in serious research projects teaches students about research methodology, data collection, and analysis.


Whereas, Undergraduate research not only inspire students to pursue graduate training, but it also motivates them to become future leaders in their field of study.
