## **Purpose:**

The Digital Commons Annual Report is a document that interested parties may use as a means of monitoring the yearly progress of Florida International University Libraries' institutional repository.

## **Background**

FIU's Institutional Repository is a full-text, online, open access repository and publishing platform for the scholarship, creative output and history of FIU. The goals of the repository are to:

- Serve as a persistent and centralized access point for FIU scholarship and creative works
- Promote faculty and student research to a global community
- Preserve the history, growth and development of FIU

The Institutional Repository is managed and administered by Jill Krefft, Institutional Repository Coordinator, Jamie Rogers, Assistant Director Digital Collections Center, and Eva Reyes Ciserno, Digital Collections Specialist, with additional support from the staff of the FIU Digital Collections Center and the University Graduate School.

## **FY 2011-2012 Highlights**

- Submission of Electronic Dissertations and Theses became mandatory in the Spring 2012 semester. Students still submit hard copy drafts, but the final versions must be submitted through Digital Commons.
- Digital Commons now provides access to the SelectedWorks service, which provides faculty and staff individual pages for the organization, archiving, and dissemination of all their work.
- Jill Krefft joined the team as the Institutional Repository Coordinator in March of 2012.
- Substantial growth of collections occurred in 2011-2012. New collections included all FIU Course Catalogs, FIU Photographic Archive, and FCE LTER.
