Purpose:

The Digital Commons Annual Report is a document that interested parties may use as a means of monitoring the yearly progress of Florida International University Libraries' institutional repository.

Background

FIU's Institutional Repository is a full-text, online, open access repository and publishing platform for the scholarship, creative output and history of FIU. The goals of the repository are to:

- Serve as a persistent and centralized access point for FIU scholarship and creative works
- Promote faculty and student research to a global community
- Preserve the history, growth and development of FIU

The Institutional Repository is managed and administered by Jill Krefft, Institutional Repository Coordinator, Jamie Rogers, Assistant Department Head Digital Collections Center, and Margarita Mirabel, Archivist with additional support from the staff of the FIU Digital Collections Center and the University Graduate School.

FY 2012-2013 Highlights

- Digital Commons published its first peer reviewed journal with the Chaplain School of Hospitality Management, *The Hospitality Review*.
- Digital Commons underwent a full interface redesign which was launched in December of 2012.
- Digital Commons saw tremendous growth in the last year with over 2,100 new records added. New collections this year included *The Hospitality Review*, South Florida Education Research Conference proceedings, Department of Biological Sciences Undergraduate Honors Theses, and Western Hemispheric Security Analysis Center (WHEMSAC) papers.
- Digital Commons also saw a 59% increase in full text downloads from 130,593 in FY 2011-2012 to 207,647 in FY 2012-2013.
